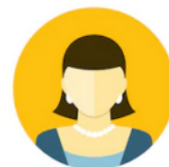
- Collection and characterization of native plants and related microorganisms

- Biomass production for energetic purposes











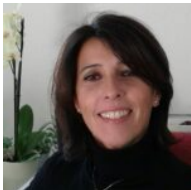
